

Final Senior Project: Students will create a Spanish yearbook.

A. Each student will be responsible for:

1. A Biography Page with a picture of the student and a paragraph of at least 150 words.
 - The paragraph should include:
 - a. Information out you
 - b. Memories of your Spanish experience here at Pioneer
 - c. Your life story, sports, activities or events

2. 2 other pages for the book. Some ideas are:
 - a. Future Plans
 1. University / Future Page: where or what you will be doing next year
 2. Where will you be in 10 Years Page: humor page; a quote from each student
 - b. Student / Senior Picture Page: Each student must submit a picture for the yearbook
 - c. Baby Picture Page (optional)
 - d. What will you remember about Rita Page
 - e. Surveys: the book should include surveys about the class and the class of 2017-18
 - f. Art Pages: The book should have an "art" section, to be completed by the class artists.
 - g. recipe page

Other ideas:

- A. Warning Page for future students: What to expect from Rita in AP class
- B. Picture Page with captions
- C. Quote Page
- D. Political Cartoon Page

Please do not use any copyrighted "anything" in the yearbook.

- Send the Student Bio in an d email attachment to Rita (if you want any editing do this soon!)
- If you choose to write a Bio for a friend, then you must have your friend write a bio about you. In other words, you must work in pairs. You may simply write your own Bio. The goal is not to have anyone left out of the book
- All pages must be turned in on **May 24st** in _____ format (excluding the cover). Rita will assemble the pages and have the book bound and copied.
- If you choose to use senior picture (or baby pictures), you must give the senior pictures and/or baby pictures or copies of the pictures directly to the person who is building this page.
- If students fail to turn in all required materials by May 24th it will not be included in the book and you will forever be forgotten. Not to mention receive a zero for you final assignment.
